BIRTH, DEATH, MARRIAGE & ADOPTION CERTIFICATES

Birth, Death, Marriage and Adoption Certificates are issued by the Registrar General in Guyana. It is therefore necessary for the application to be made directly to that Office.

PROCESS

- Obtain the application form from the High Commission or online.
- Complete the form ensuring that you enter accurate information (for example, the exact place of birth in Guyana, that is, street, hospital or village).
- Send form and fees (postal order for £3 made payable to the Registrar General), to the Registrar General. This amount covers the processing fee and return postage.
- Applicants outside the UK should forward an international postal order or an international bank draft in the amount of five US dollars (US\$5.00) to cover the processing fee and return postage.
- It is advised that a covering letter be sent with the application stating very clearly the address to which the certificate should be returned.
