

Guyana Ratifies IMO Treaties



On 20 February 2019 His Excellency Frederick Hamley Case High Commissioner of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana to the United Kingdom deposited eleven IMO related Instruments of ratification/ accession with Secretary General Kitack Lim of the International Maritime Organisation.

The Treaties address several maritime areas of importance including marine pollution, dumping waste at sea and responding to pollution incidents involving hazardous and noxious substances.
